What does it take

Robbie was a mangled mess when she first arrived at Cherry Street. She wasn't in a tangle that anyone could see - physically. She had no signs of physical abuse, no bruises or abrasions. Her clothes weren't tattered or ruined. In every way that you would see Robbie, she was 'fine'.

Robbie however, was a veteran. And like so many people and veterans - it wasn't her outward appearance that was mangled. If you can't tell a book by its cover, the same is true for people. Outward appearance can often mask an inward problem. A new pair of pants, a clean jacket, newer shoes, fresh socks or a freshly pressed shirt would not solve nor even come close to Robbie's troubles.

Poverty, is not always physical. Poverty is mostly inside a person. Inside a community. We can't solve, we mustn't try to solve an inward 'ruin' of a life with a physical response. We can't continue to believe that the mangled mess of a person is so easily resolved with a physical response; new job, new home, new shoes, new life. As if changing any of these things without an inward walk of health - works.

The reason why you and I support the work of Cherry Street is simply yet dynamically, because we understand that the work of and with people requires God's personal touch in their lives - on the inside.

So for 70 years, you and I have kept our promise to one another. Those promises have been for and on behalf of the countless "Robbie's" who reach our doors each day. Your parents and grandparents before you and for me, generations of exceptional leaders at Cherry Street have kept the doors open.

NICHOLAS IS ON THE PATH TO RESTORED INDEPENDENCE.

Nicholas is born and raised in Toledo, with the exception of the 8 years he spent in the Navy. While in the Navy, Nicholas was a Yeoman he was managing classified documents and feeding critical data to his superiors. His service was vital to the safety of America and the safety of others in the Armed Forces.

Like so many that come to Cherry Street, Nicholas is a smart, articulate man with a history peppered with success. But Nicholas is a trusting man too. The people Nicholas thought were his friends, were in fact criminals. Having so much stolen from him, Nicholas lost his apartment and couldn't afford his vehicle.

Cherry Street is here to help Nicholas. While Nicholas is saving up his money to get his life back, his vehicle running and a place to call home, he has been going to Bible study and has been helping out around the Cherry Street buildings. "I'm on a mission that come July I'll be on my

own." Nicholas goes to a Saturday morning Bible Study at his church, where he tries to mentor the younger men. "Jesus is the ONLY guy who can save you from yourself", Nicholas is quick to add.

Nicholas recently recalled his service in the military in regards to being a victim of theft. "I learned a lot from my time in the Navy. I think that's what got me to really know what I needed to do, the right way- not the wrong way." As Nicholas was sitting at Cherry Street on a cold, rainy day he called upon God for help. He was looking for a way home, a way to make better decisions and the peace only Jesus Christ can offer. In that moment, God revealed to Nicholas the way to trust people, and to see through those who would do harm to Nicholas. God also has been working on Nicholas' heart for how to be a good friend but to protect himself. "He has been showing me where to go, where not to go and what not to do."



SERVING VETERANS

The population of veterans of the armed forces who are homeless is an alarming statistic. As a partner with Cherry Street, WSOS has Joyce Alridge work within the Life Revitalization Center to assist those served by Cherry Street and those in the community. As veteran men and women come to Cherry Street, Joyce is a valuable resource.

Joyce is helping veterans escape homelessness and poverty by wrapping them in supportive services. A vet who is chronically homeless cannot get any of the usual resources such as SNAP (also known as food stamps) or Veteran Administrative benefits. She is connecting them with housing, employment and benefits. Overcoming obstacles is what Joyce excels at.

"I have always had a passion for anyone who holds their head down. I've always had a passion to help that person get back up again. We were all created to be better and better. When I see a homeless person I look at something killed that desire to achieve. I want to give that person hope and to remind them they were wonderfully and fearfully made [Psalm 139:14]," says Joyce.

Cherry Street's partnership with WSOS and the resource Joyce is to those in our community is vital.

"I recently sat down at one of our dinner tables and joined a man named Darren, whom I learned started staying with us about a week prior. He had been living with a few people that became addicted to heroin, and he had to get out of that setting but had nowhere to go. Darren mentioned he had to get going as soon as breakfast was over so he could get to work. I asked where he worked, and he slowly unzipped his coat to reveal a chef's coat, and shared that he was the head cook for a new restaurant that opened downtown.

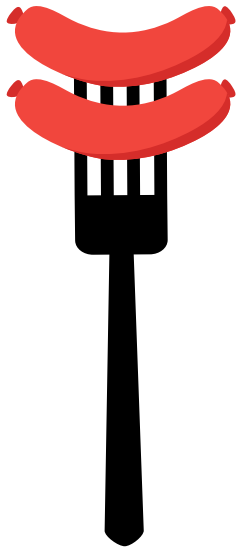

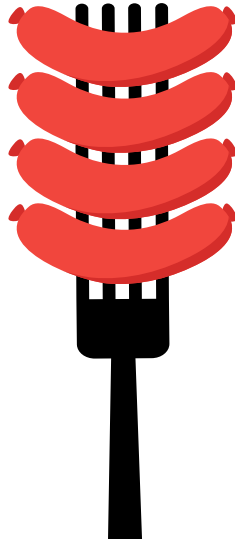

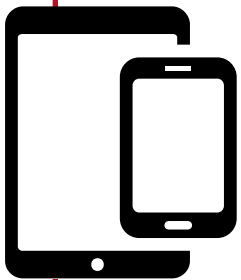
